It may be timely, as a result of the weather we have experienced recently, to remind members of the procedure adopted regarding play during inclement weather. Rule 6-8 clearly outlines the actions to be taken when play is suspended by the host club. However, in the absence of any official directions we may act independently. Should playing conditions become dangerous or if certain parts of the course become unplayable, as was case at Long Reef, players are entitled to seek advice from our match committee of the day regarding the continuation of play. The committee may decided to:

- Abandon play and cancel the competition.
- Suspend play until conditions clear.
- Instruct play to continue.

The match committee of the day will be appointed prior to each event by the elected committee of the Association and will consist of three members of that committee one of which will be either the Captain or President.
